

COOKIE POLICY

Effective: September 7, 2018

Like many companies, Cronos Group Inc. and its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively “**Cronos Group**”, “**We**” or “**Our**”) use "cookies" on our websites to improve the user experience. Cookies are tiny files containing a string of letters and numbers that are sent to your computer or mobile device by web page servers. They help us distinguish you from other users of our websites. Cookies cannot be executed as code nor can they be used to deliver viruses. Cookies do not enable Cronos Group to access or read any other information on your hard drive - even if cookies are stored there.

Cookies may be associated with identifiable information you have provided while registering for a Cronos Group Service or while logged in, such as your email address when subscribing to a Cronos Group newsletter. This helps us provide you with a more personalized user experience, e.g. to enable us to deliver content relevant to your interests.

Cookies may also be deployed on behalf of Cronos Group by partners who provide services on our websites in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

The data generated through the use of cookies on Cronos Group’s websites can be used for various purposes including the following:

- **Strictly Necessary:** These technical cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around our websites and use its features, such as accessing secure areas or online storefronts of the websites. These cookies are only temporarily stored while you are using our websites and are deleted from your device once you close your browser session;
- **Functionality:** These personalization cookies allow our websites to remember choices you make such as user name, language or region you are in and provide a more enhanced personal experience. These cookies will expire within 24 hours;
- **Performance and Statistics:** These analysis cookies collect information about how visitors use our websites, for instance which pages visitors go to most often and if they receive error messages. These cookies are used to improve the functionality of our websites.

In some instances, we may also include web beacons (also known as page tags or tracking pixels) and other technologies in our online services or newsletters. A web beacon is a graphic on a website or in a newsletter which is used to understand whether emails are opened or links in the emails are clicked. This technology helps us improve the content and relevancy of our newsletters for our recipients.

If you continue to use the Cronos Group websites, this indicates that **you consent** to the use of cookies and the other technologies described.

You can configure your web browser’s settings to accept or refuse cookies or similar technologies, or to notify you each time cookies or similar technologies are sent to you. However, if your browser is set to reject cookies and similar technologies, cookie-enabled websites will not recognize you when you return to the website and some functionality of the Cronos Group online experience may be lost.
